# EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE BALANCE SHEET AND THE RECORD OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE.

#### **GENERAL**

The financial statements of Humanity in Action The Netherlands have been drawn up by Agaath Administraties.

#### ACCOUNTING PERIOD

These financial statements have been drawn up on the basis of an accounting period of one year. The financial year is concurrent with the calender year.

#### ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES

#### General

The accounting principles are based on historical cost. Unless otherwise indicated, assets and liabilities are included at nominal value. Income and expenditure are allocated to the period to which they apply.

## Transactions in foreign currencies

Transactions denominated by foreign currencies are converted at the exchange rate applying on the transaction date. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated by foreign currencies are converted at the exchange rate applying on the balance sheet date.

#### Donations and contributions

Donations and contributions are recorded in the year for which they were generated, unless indicated otherwise.

#### In kind donations

In kind donations are recorded in the year in which they are granted and are valuated at the fair value in The Netherlands.

#### Tangible fixed assets

The tangible fixed assets are stated at the acquisition cost, less straight-line depreciation.

The depreciation is calculated on the basis of acquisition cost less residual value and the estimated useful life of the related asset. In general the estimated useful life of the mentioned office equipment is 5 years.



#### Cost allocation

Direct project expenditures are allocated to the programs and projects as realized. Salary expenditures are allocated on the basis of a substantiated estimation of the division of working hours realized annually by staff of the organization.

Overhead expenditures are allocated in terms of percentage to each program and project. From 2019 onwards, Humanity in Action The Netherlands will work with timesheets, to further strengthen the existing allocation processes.

#### Continuity reserve

On May 1st 2019 the Board of Humanity in Action The netherlands formally decided to change the general reserve that was accumulated over the last years into a continuty reserve. The continuity reserve is meant to warrant the continuity in the case of (temporary) drop in income.

As of December 31st 2018 the reserve totals  $\[ \epsilon \]$  45.410. Humanity in Action The Netherlands strives to ensure the continuity reserve covers 6 months of salary payments and 1 year of office-rent. For the year 2019 this would mean a total of  $\[ \epsilon \]$  54.909.
